6 Sawyer Point One Water Filters = 6 Million Gallons of Purified Water

In Uganda there is a dire need of both access to water and purification of water. By pairing The Ugandan Water Project's rainwater collection systems with the purity achieved by Sawyer's Point One hollow fiber membrane filters both problems are tackled.

Sawyer filters are used both as an addition to the system by attaching it to the tap and as a standalone system designed to use any existing source of water. Through partnering with Sawyer and people like you, The Ugandan Water Project has been able to bring hundreds of filters to Uganda, adding them to new installations, retrofitting older projects with them, and giving them to communities to use with existing sources of water. Each filter lasts up to 10 years and can filter 1,000,000 gallons in their lifetime. Each Sawyer Point One Filter comes complete with barrel, connections, transport to Uganda, installation, and training!
